Council will receive a presentation on the 2025-2028 Stouffville Visitor Plan by Central Counties Tourism and Town staff.

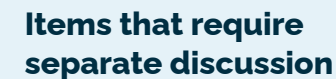
Council will receive a presentation from Latcham Art Centre regarding wayfinding signage for the gallery.

- 1 Council will be asked to approve a Notice of Decision for a Draft Plan of Subdivision to allow five blocks and 14 residential lots on a property along Aurora Rd., east of McCowan Rd.
- 2 Council will be asked to designate the property at 15223 Hwy 48 as a heritage property under the Ontario Heritage Act.
- 3 Council will be asked to approve the 2026 budget timetable and will receive information about the 2026 Budget Public Engagement Plan.
- 4 Council will be asked to approve the creation of an Urban Farm at Franklin Field, which includes up to four mixed-use garden plots (each 50 by 100 feet) where fresh produce will be grown and shared with the community.



- 1 Council will receive a letter from York Region about the provincial funding shortfall for health and human services programs, for information.

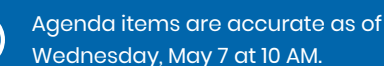


- 1 Council will be asked to direct staff to review the Town's current Firearms By-law and compare it with by-laws in nearby municipalities and report back by June.
