# Staff Reports

- Council will be asked to approve the Terms of Reference for a Village of Stouffville Advisory Committee and to approve a tax levy to support their initiatives.

- Council will be asked to approve an amendment to the Parks by-law regarding park hours and to the Fireworks by-law regarding the age limit for fireworks sale and possession.
- Council will be asked to approve the contract award for the Town's telephone system and services.
- Council will be asked to approve the installation of automated speed cameras throughout Stouffville and to delegate to staff the ability to choose their locations.
- Council will be asked to direct staff to hold a 6 Statutory Public Meeting regarding amendments to the Town's Parking by-law.
- Council will be asked to approve the Town's Housing Action Plan.
- Council will receive an overview of the new 8 Provincial Planning Statement.

- Council will be asked to accept an in-kind contribution from developers LivGreen as a contribution to the Community Benefits Charge.
- Council will be asked to award a 3-year contract for winter sidewalk maintenance and windrow clearing to Todd Brothers for \$502,600 plus taxes.

### **Member Motions**

- Mayor Lovatt will table a motion to direct staff to examine how the Town can increase supports to the Stouffville Strawberry Festival.
- Councillor Kroon will table a motion to direct staff to survey area municipalities on the remuneration for all Council Appointed Committees and report back to Council with a recommendation.
- Mayor Lovatt will table a motion to ask the Province to make amendments to the Municipal Act and/or Planning Act to allow municipalities to declare illegal land uses, and to issue penalty notices.
