It appears that Six Nations has provided input into the proposal to proceed to mechanical topsoil removal. Of the remaining Indigenous communities, the following communities appear to have had a continuing interest in the project:

- The Huron Wendat First Nation requested a copy of the Stage 3 assessment report. They provided a history of that community to be incorporated into the Stage 4 report. Did they provide any input into the proposed Stage 4 strategy? Did they provide a specific statement in regard to mechanical topsoil removal?
- The Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation showed a continued interest in the project though they were ultimately unable to provide a representative. Did they provide any input into the proposed Stage 4 strategy? Did they provide a specific statement in regard to mechanical topsoil removal?
- Curve Lake First Nation and Chippewas of Georgina Island First Nation showed an interest in the project. Did they provide any input into the proposed Stage 4 strategy? Did they provide a specific statement in regard to mechanical topsoil removal?"

Were any attempts made to contact any of the Huron Wendat First Nation, Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation, Curve Lake First Nation or Chippewas of Georgina Island First Nation specifically regarding the proposed strategy of mechanical topsoil removal? Was more than one attempt made? Were attempts made through multiple means, e.g., email and telephone call.

**RE: Advice on Fieldwork Strategy for MHSTCI Project Information Form Number P029-1065-2022 (Stage 4).
Archeoworks Inc. Project Number 060-WS8371-21.**

We are writing to the *Ministry of Heritage, Sport, Tourism and Culture Industries* to seek advice regarding a decision to halt further Stage 4 AA unit excavation and to proceed to mechanical topsoil stripping and feature excavation at the H1 (BaGu-213) Site. The BaGu-213 Site is located within Block 19, Registered Plan 65M-2571 and part of Lot 20, Concession 4, in the Geographic Township of Whitchurch, former County of York, now in the Town of Aurora, Regional Municipality of York, Ontario.

The Stage 2 Archaeological Assessment (AA) identified two archaeological sites of Euro-Canadian affiliation - the H1 (BaGu-213) and H2 (BaGu-214) Sites. Stage 3 assessment was deemed necessary only for the former site. The Stage 2 and 3 AAs associated with this site resulted in a collection of 2,136 Euro-Canadian artifacts and three (3) Indigenous artifacts (*see Maps 1-3; Table 1*). Per the *2011 Standards and Guidelines for Consultant Archaeologists (2011 S&G)*, Stage 4 excavation was recommended. The Stage 3 AA report recommended hand excavation around the historic Euro-Canadian midden areas corresponding to units 295-505 and 295-510 and around the Indigenous ceramic sherds corresponding to units 290-480, 300-500 and 290-505: to 1) recover a greater amount of information about the lifestyles of the site occupants; and 2) to understand deposition process which resulted in the artifact accumulation within the core of the site and the distribution of Indigenous artifacts across the site. Since the site retains a Woodland Period (Middle to Late) component as well as being primarily post-1830, the balance of the H1 (BaGu-213) site outside the block excavation area must be subjected to mechanical topsoil removal to uncover any subsurface cultural features.

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To-date, 99 one-metre-square block units have been excavated around the test units recommended in the Stage 3 AA report and 9,751¹ artifacts have been retrieved during Stage 4 archaeological investigations (*see Maps 4-5*).

Regarding the Euro-Canadian component, the purpose of Stage 4 block excavation is to capture the midden deposit that may be present in the topsoil. Furthermore, this ensures a large volume of artifactual data is recovered if no features are discovered during subsequent mechanical topsoil stripping, or features have little or no artifacts.

The material recovered within the topsoil layer (consisting of one single distinct layer) around these units are similar in terms of horizontal and vertical distribution. Artifacts encountered were also similar in terms of type and timeframe throughout the site, and included: ceramics, pane glass, bottle glass, faunal, smoking pipes, brick, and nails. Five potential Euro-Canadian cultural features have been encountered during block excavation.

The H1 (BaGu-213) site artifacts are indicative of a domestic Euro-Canadian homestead occupied from at least the 1830s into the 1860s, with the bulk of the collection dating from the 1830s to 1850s period. Though the first mention found for a domestic dwelling is in the 1861 *Census Record* for a two-storey wood house, the house was likely built prior to this, possibly by an unknown individual (ca.1837-1846) and re-used by subsequent inhabitants William Dawson (ca.1846-1850), the Walkers (ca.1850-1868), and possible tenants of the latter, George Nightingale (1855-1857) and Levi Richardson (1860-1868). This house would have been occupied by the above noted individuals into the mid- to late 19th century, before a new two-storey frame house and associated barn was built elsewhere on the property by Andrew Lambie (1868-1887) or Michael Guthrie (1887-1938). The original homestead was probably abandoned around this time, and the land converted to agricultural fields. As such, the H1 (BaGu-213) site represents the first phase of settlement and house construction on Lot 20, Concession 4, and the newer two-storey house, the second. The latter is believed to correspond with the H2 (BaGu-214) site, a late-19th century farmstead located approximately 200 metres southwest of the H1 (BaGu-213) Site area (*see Maps 6-7*).

Regarding the Indigenous component, three Indigenous ceramic sherds were recovered during the Stage 3 AA of the H1 (BaGu-213) site: one small, exfoliated vessel body sherd and two smoking pipe sherds. These artifacts have been dated to the Woodland Period, sometime from the Middle to Late Woodland (ca.200 BC to AD 1600 or 2400-500 B.P). Despite the excavation of an additional test-units surrounding these Stage 3 finds, as well as the added block excavation tied to the Euro-Canadian midden component, no additional Indigenous material or features were recovered during the Stage 4 block excavation. It is, therefore, unlikely these finds are tied to any sort of settlement within the site area.

The material in the ploughzone of any site is a broken-down sample of the material that has been brought up over time from sub-surface features through cultural transforms (i.e., agricultural ploughing). Therefore, the most intact and meaningful data is recovered from features, with the surface material representing a fragmented sample of feature material. With no additional Indigenous artifacts recovered, the confirmed presence of intact Euro-Canadian cultural features containing artifacts, as well as a high volume of artifacts already collected from the topsoil during block excavations, which is similar in terms of horizontal and vertical distribution, and in terms of type and timeframe across the entire site tied to the Euro-Canadian component, it has, therefore, been determined that there is no further value in additional topsoil excavation.

While it is understood that Stage 4 hand excavations must proceed until there is a drop in material and extending two-metres beyond cultural features, given the complete stratigraphic understanding of the topsoil/subsoil interface, the high volume of artifacts collected (n=9,751 artifacts) from the full excavation of 99 one-metre-units, the redundancies in material being collected, the lack of any additional Indigenous material recovered, as well as the ability to recover more valuable intact subsurface artifacts and data through feature excavation, we seek the

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Map 1: Stage 2 AA results of depicting the H1 (BaGu-213) Site location.

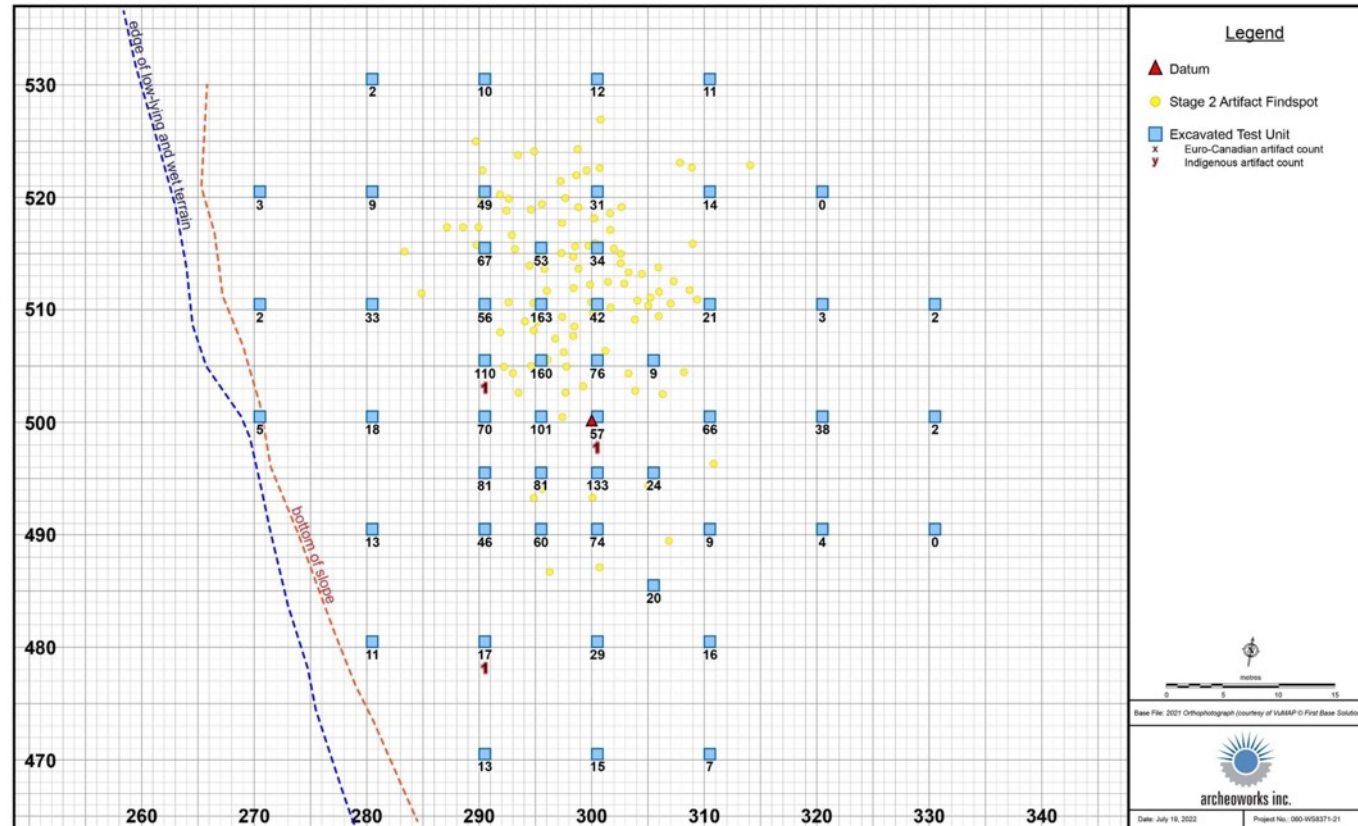

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Map 2: Stage 3 AA results of the H1 (BaGu-213) Site.

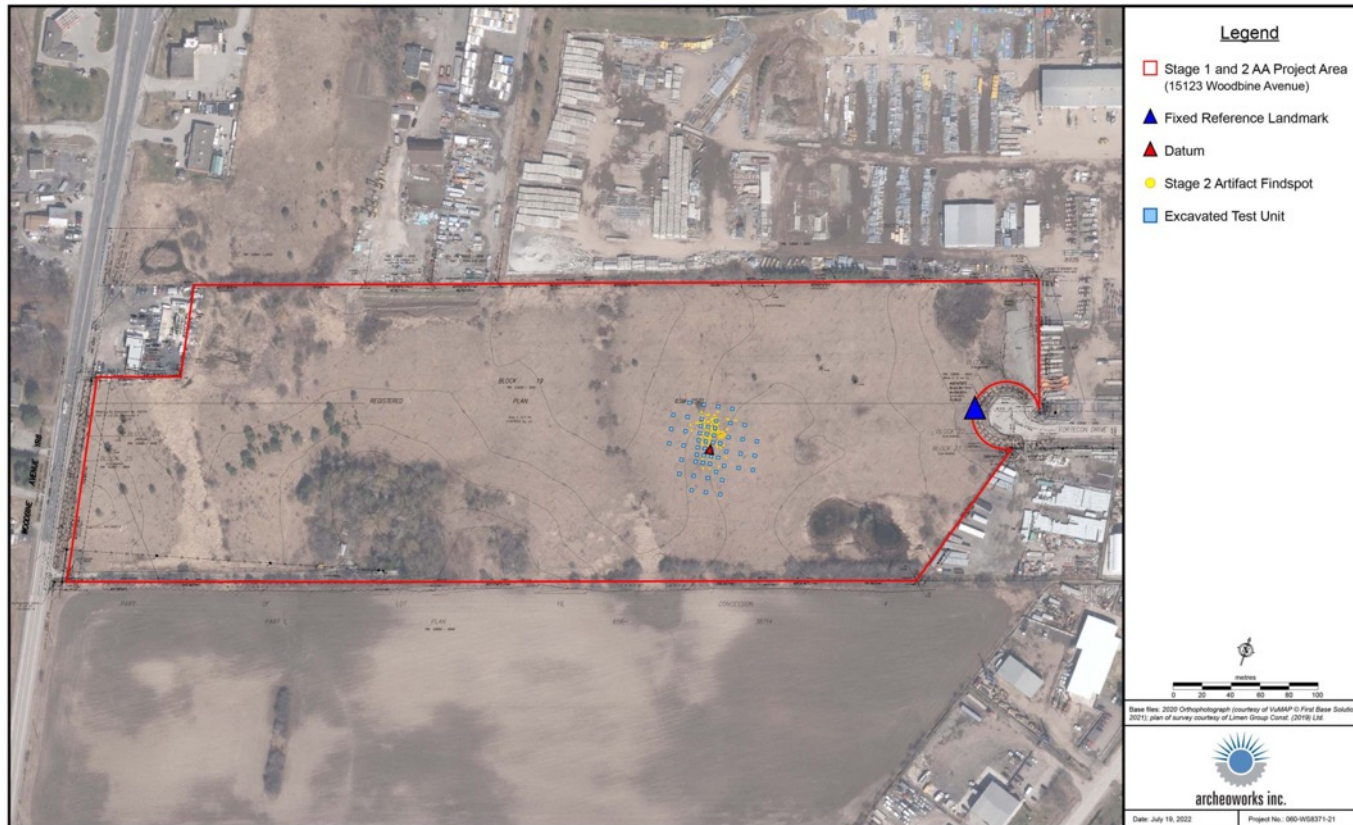

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Map 3: Stage 3 AA of the H1 (BaGu-213) Site within a topographic plan.

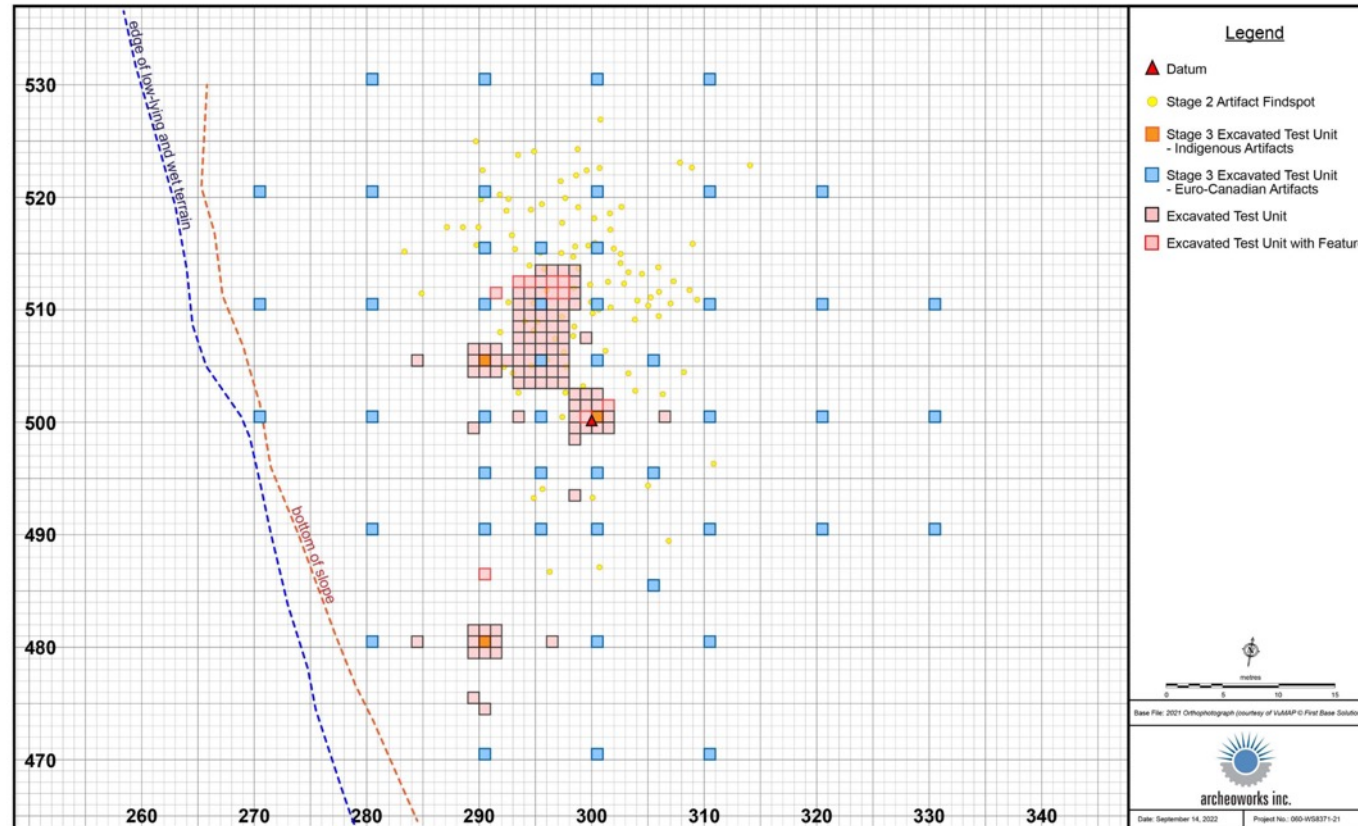

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Map 4: Stage 4 excavation results to-date at the H1 (BaGu-213) Site.

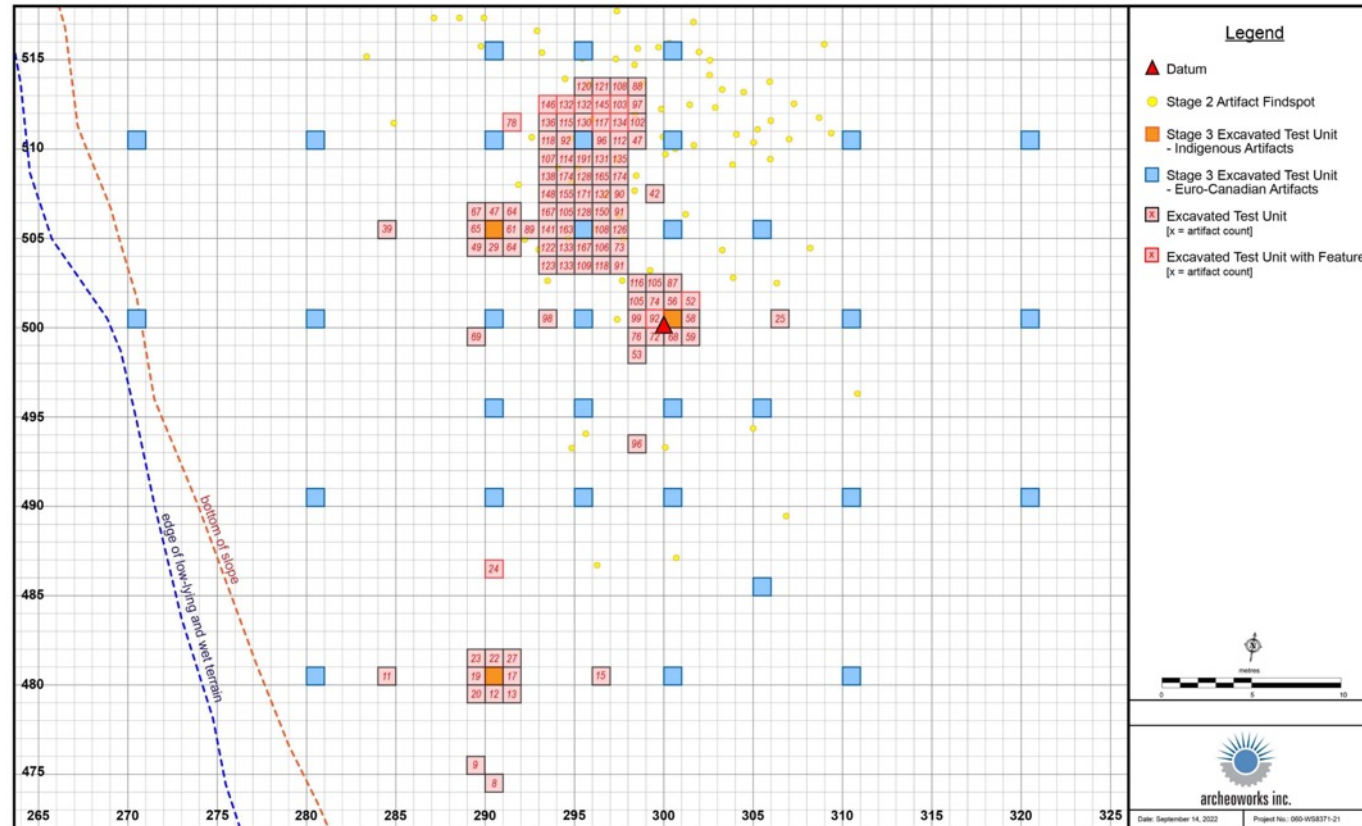

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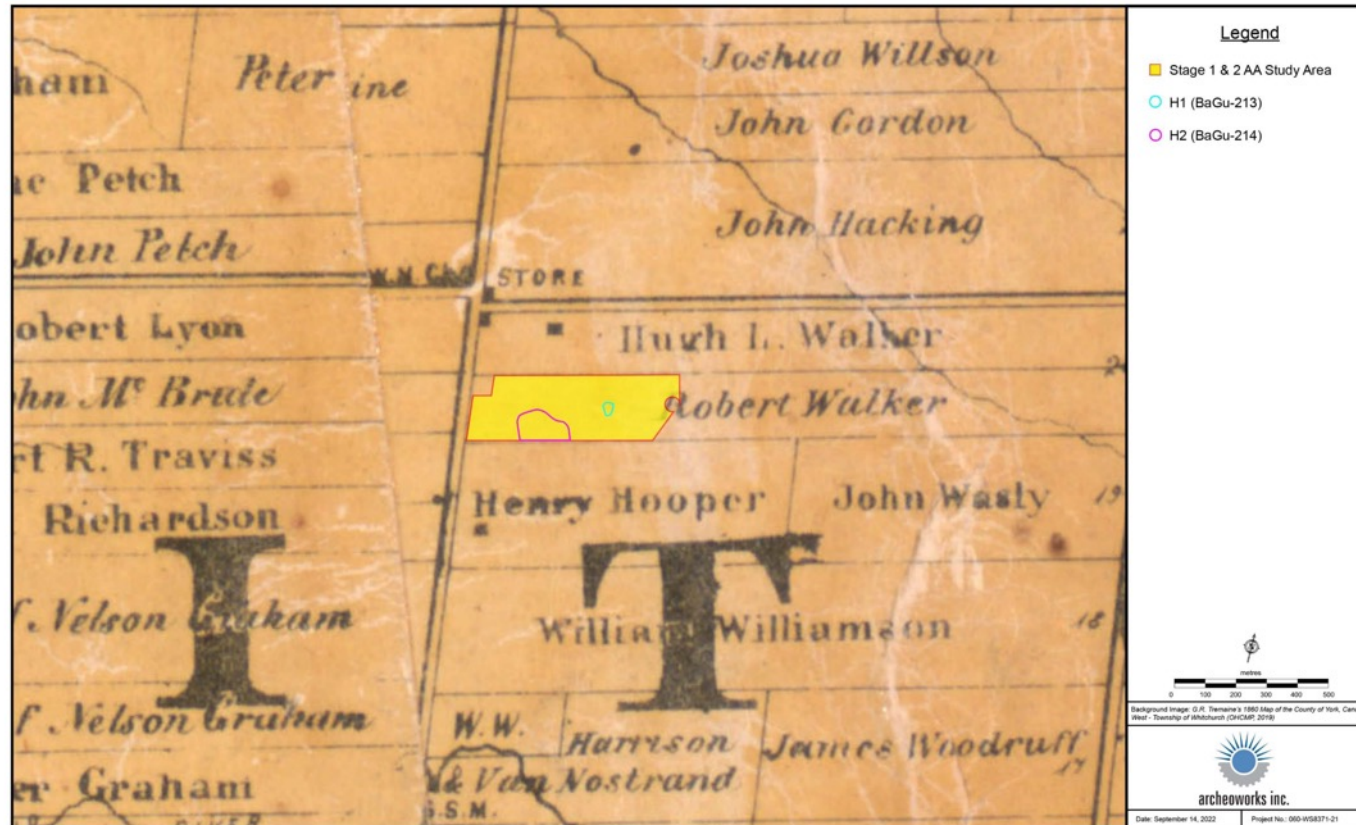

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Map 6: H1 (BaGu-213) Site Area within G.R. Tremaine's 1860 Map of the County of the County of York (OHCMP, 2019).

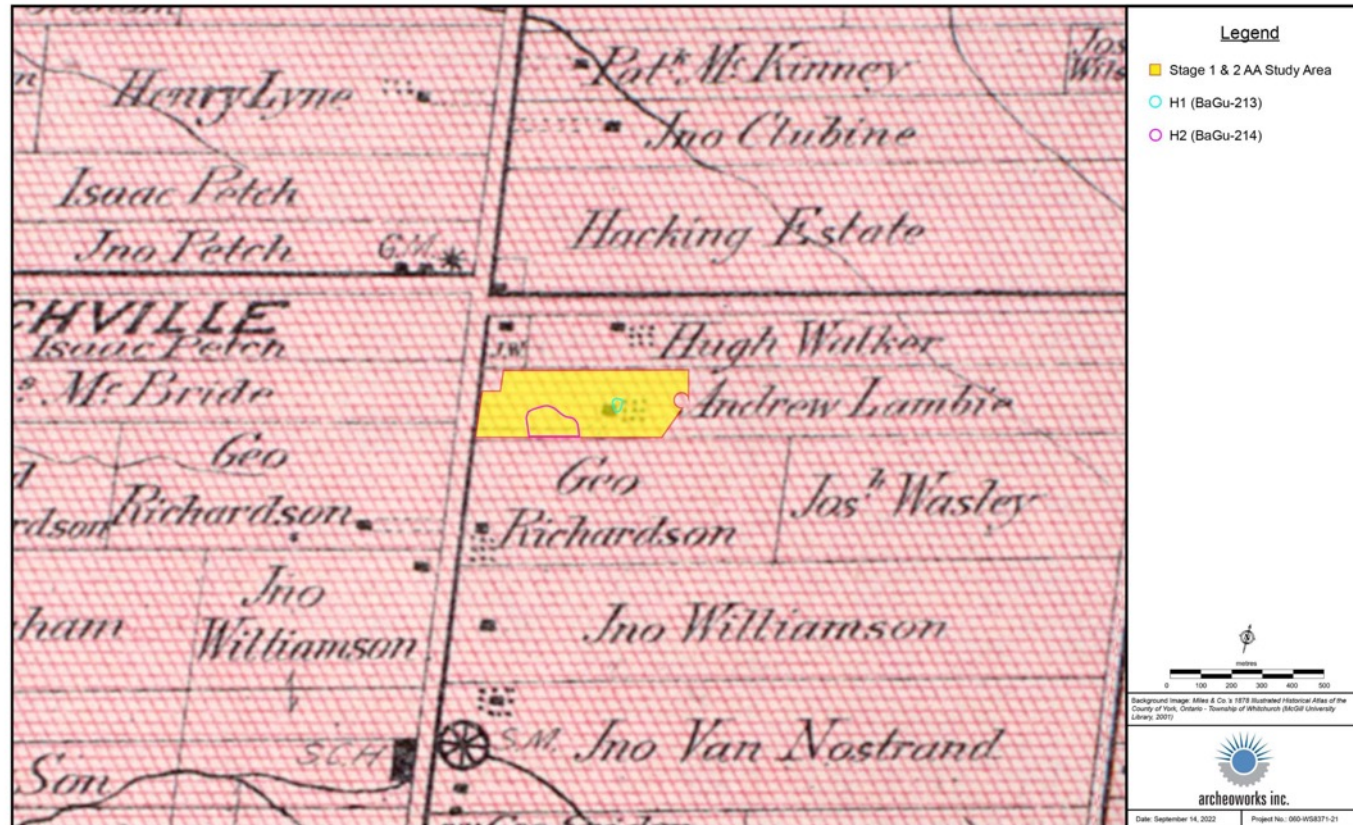
