Community Update

Where things stand

The Town remains committed to the development of the Stouffville Multi-Sport Dome, an important new multi-sport recreational facility that will provide year-round opportunities for residents, local sports organizations and athletes from across the community.

Since the partnership with Mentana Group was announced only 15 months ago, the facility design and programming have been shaped to respond to the needs of local and regional sport organizations and to maximize the long-term benefit to the community.



Construction and procurement are being carefully sequenced

Planning for critical construction materials, equipment and specialized building components is well advanced, with significant deposits and commitments already made to secure production capacity and lead times. Given the evolving tariff environment and its impact on sourcing and costs, procurement and delivery schedules are being carefully recalibrated, while also identifying opportunities to support **'Buy Canadian'** objectives.

Taking these steps now is the responsible approach and helps ensure the project moves into construction with key materials, suppliers and delivery schedules properly aligned.



Provincial and federal support

The project has attracted support at both the provincial and federal levels of government. Over the past several months, Mentana Group and the Town have been working through the processes associated with this support and coordinating the project schedule accordingly.



An extended timeline, for the right reasons

While this work has extended the original construction timeline, it represents an important step toward delivering a significant new recreational asset for Stouffville and ensuring the project is positioned for long-term success.

When will construction begin?



Now

Completing the remaining project and government processes and preparing for construction. A traffic study is also being undertaken as part of the project planning initiative.



Early spring 2027

Site work and construction begin. Starting in early spring provides the window to complete the major site, foundation, building and dome work.



2027–28 indoor season

The construction schedule has been built around the indoor sports calendar, with the objective of having the facility available during the 2027–28 indoor season.

What is being built?

A major year-round indoor sports and recreation destination serving Stouffville and the surrounding region, with a flexible design that accommodates recreational participants, local sports organizations, development programs, leagues, tournaments and high-performance athletes, while providing significantly more indoor recreational capacity for the community.
